Anti-Doping Policy

Canada First Academy adheres to Canada Soccer's anti-doping policy which has been created in conjunction with CCES and the CADP. CFA educates coaches, players and parents about this anti-doping policy through staff/volunteer meetings, player/parent meetings and Club policy manuals.

[Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport \(CCES\)](#) is the custodian of [Canadian Anti-Doping Program \(CADP\)](#); the set of rules that govern anti-doping in Canada. The CADP consists of several components such as in-and out-of-competition testing, education, medical exemptions, and the consequences of doping violations.

The CADP is compliant with the World Anti-Doping Code and all international standards. Canada Soccer has adopted the CCES and CADP which means that our academy is a part of a world-class anti-doping program that is designed to protect athletes' rights and ensure a level playing field. Canada Soccer's anti-doping policy reflects and supports the CADP.
